Fire Number Signs

Fire number signs help emergency workers such as firefighters or other first responders find your address if you have an emergency at your home.

A recent survey of Fire Number Signs was completed in Sunfish Lake and nearly 10% of the signs were faded or damaged to the point of being unreadable or were not visibly displayed at all. When first responders are in transit minutes can make a huge difference and having your fire sign in a very visible location is important.

Display your sign toward the street along your driveway to identify your home. Use a metal post that is at least 5' long so that the sign will be visible above tall grass or winter snow. Many residents have their signs near their mailboxes. Position your sign where it will be visible from the street and is not hidden by your mailbox. It may occasionally be necessary to prune branches or mow grass that hides your sign. If shrubbery overgrows your sign perhaps moving it is the best plan.

If your sign is damaged or lost please contact the City Forester to get a new sign ordered.
