Two burning permits were issued during May. Permits were again available following the recent rains and green up.

Arbor Day was held on May 1st from 2-4 pm at the new wildflower garden near the corner of Salem Church Road and Windy Hill Road. Good attendance and lots of neighbors driving by and waving.

Weight limit signs were taken down on April 2nd.

Picked up and disposed of a refrigerator, box spring, and other debris dumped along Angell Road. Please be aware of illegal dumping to either catch the dumpers (call 911) or report it to me so that I can get the debris removed quickly so a little debris does not inspire more dumping.

Musser Park trail has been mowed and the deer protection tubes removed from young City trees. The process to create five new wildflower plantings has begun along Salem Church Road. Spot sprayed burdock in various areas in Harmon Park.
