1. **Call to Order**

2. **Presentation of Flock Safety**

Bo Manor, Sales Manager for Flock System went over the presentation on how the Flock System works to solve and eliminate crime and how it works with the local police department. After the presentation, Mayor O’Leary went through the questions that he received from residents regarding this system.

The meeting was opened for public comment.

- Shari and Roger Wilsey spoke not in favor of purchasing the Flock System. Strongly believe this would not prevent crime in Sunfish Lake.
- Erik Funk believes this is the wrong choice for the city at this time. This system would not have prevented the crimes that occurred in recent years. Also has concerns about who has access to this information. We do not have accept their terms for the agreement.
- Mary Jo Meuleners who lives on the west side of Horseshoe Lake requests that consideration be given that if the Flock Security System is approved that a camera be installed in this area.
- Joel Sedgeman is strongly in favor of the Flock System and is willing to pay to feel more secure in the City.
- Josh Miller is not in favor of the Flock System and does not any type of system watching him.
- Crystal Barber does not have an opinion as of yet regarding the system but asked if the city can share the costs of the system with another city or is there other funding options available. Staff will look into this.
- Adam Stein asked what type of deterrent this system would have.
