- ✓ **Zero (0) illicit discharges reported in 2024-2025**
- ✓ City field staff received illicit discharge training

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MINIMUM CONTROL MEASURE 4

- ✓ Zero (0) active construction sites greater than one acre within the City



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MINIMUM CONTROL MEASURE 5

- ✓ Maintained and tracked permanent stormwater treatment BMPs such as ponds, infiltration basins, and raingardens

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MINIMUM CONTROL MEASURE 6

- ✓ Quarterly inspection and maintenance of Public Works' Yard and facilities
- ✓ Public Works staff and Police/Fire staff training
- ✓ Completed required inspections for City Ponds and Outfalls
