Minimum Control Measure 1

Public Education and Outreach

- Informational material available on City website
- Newsletters distributed to residents
- The City held an annual spring clean up

Minimum Control Measure 2

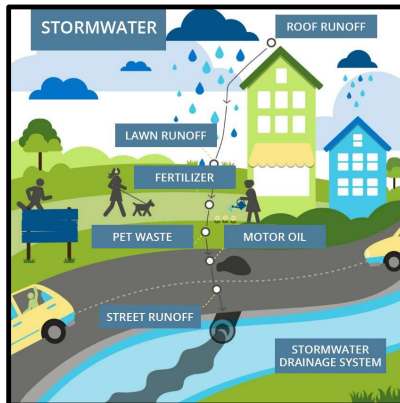
Public Participation and Involvement

- MS4 Annual Board was published for the month of December on the City's webpage

Minimum Control Measure 3

Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination

- Documentation and response to an illicit discharge
- Illicit discharge enforcement action
 - Zero illicit discharges reported in 2023
- City field staff received illicit discharge training



Minimum Control Measure 4 & 5

Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control Post-Construction Stormwater Management

- Five active construction sites equal to or greater than 1 acre requiring a NPDES Permit
- 17 site inspections completed in 2023

Minimum Control Measure 6

Pollution Prevention and Good Housekeeping

- Completed required inspections for stormwater infrastructure of ponds, outfalls and structural stormwater BMPs

2024 MS4 Program Goals

- Increased offerings of educational materials and opportunities to citizens about the MS4 program, pollution prevention practices, and other information regarding stormwater.
