Two burning permits were issued since the last Forester's Report.

Planning for the Arbor Day Green Fair is progressing. The Arbor Day event will be held the morning of Saturday, May 3 at 5900 Zehnder Road. Attendees will be able to view ongoing projects including: reforestation, Raingarden, shoreline restoration, and pollinator habitat development. The usual opportunities to purchase baby trees, get recycling information and have discussions regarding tree topics with our neighbors will be available. A newsletter aimed at advertising the Arbor Day activities will be mailed out near the end of March. The Arbor Day Newsletter and the Arbor Day Green Fair will encourage volunteers to step up for the work of two focused committees – the **Living Firewise Committee** and the **Parks and Public Lands Committee**.

Following the most recent blizzard there was no significant tree breakage onto city streets however some branches required gentle unweighting so they would not hang down into traffic. Some of these branches will be pruned when the weather warms up.
