Eight burning permits were issued during May once the MN DNR eased burning restrictions for Dakota County.

The May 3rd Arbor Day Green Fair event was held at 5900 Zehnder Road this year. Even though or perhaps because of the perfect weather the event was lightly attended. This was one of the first decent weather weekends following our long, long winter. Trees left over from Arbor Day are being planted in parks and other public spaces in the City.

City street weight limit restriction signs were taken down on May 9.

The Tree Board met on the evening of May 22 at the home of Dick and Debbie Bancroft to discuss current tree issues. Several attendees signed up to participate with the Firewise Committee and Parks and Open Spaces Committee. An annual Tree Board meeting is a requirement of the Tree City USA program.

Cages to protect young evergreen trees from deer feeding have been installed in Harmon Park. The first mowing of the Musser Park and Harmon Park trails were completed.
