Sunfish Lake Engineer's Report for August 5, 2014

1. Engineering Activities Undertaken in the Month of July.

The following Engineer's Report reflects the activities undertaken this past month, along with the anticipated engineering activity for the month of August.

A. Building and Site Reviews: Over the past month we have been very busy with several site and building plan reviews. We also anticipate additional site reviews in August. This has been a very busy month for reviews.

2. Public Works' Activities Undertaken in the Month of July.

B. Charlton Road / Sunfish Lake Outlet Maintenance: The outlet at the lake was cleaned in early July. Around 2 to 3 yards of gravel washed back through the pipe from Charlton Road and plugged the inlet to the pipe. All of the material was removed from around the inlet area and the pipe is able to handle any discharge from the lake. The current water level of the lake was right at the pipe discharge elevation.

A. 2014 Street Reconstruction Project Update: The contractor is working on Windy Hill Road and Windy Hill Court and should have most of the work at that location completed by August 8th. Work on Windy Hill Road should be completed by August 15th. The following is a current project schedule for the Council's information:

- August 5, 2014, Council Calls for Public Assessment Hearing
- September 2, 2014, Public Assessment Hearing
- October 2014, Certify Assessments to County

3. Anticipated Engineering and Public Work Activities for the Month of August:

A. 2015-2019 CIP Update / 2015 Budget: I will be incorporating any comments from the August Council and revising the CIP and 2015 Public Works/Engineering Budget for Council review for the September meeting.

- B. Cable Guardrail Repair Status:** The original contractor that we have used in the past to repair the guardrail is not taking on anymore work this year. This is a specialty type of work and I am trying to find a different contractor to perform the work. I am hopeful that I will be able to find another contractor in August.

At this time, there are no other planned City engineering activities for the month of August.
