Below is a summary of the calls for service during the month of June 20, 2019, through July 19, 2019.

2 – False Alarm

1 – Extra Patrol

- Sick raccoon on reporting party's back deck – animal moved on its own.

1 – Crisis Mental Health

- Subject has civil commitment order – crisis requesting transport

1 - Disturbance/Disorderly
