SUBJECT: Calls for Service April 20, 2020 – May 19, 2020

Below is a summary of the calls for service during the month of April 20, 2020 through May 19, 2020.

Ordinance Violation

- Motor vehicle stored on property under a tarp – owner told to park put it in garage – owner moved to driveway and untarped – does not appear inoperable.

Motor Vehicle Accident

- EB 62 & Charlton – car vs. deer

Medical

- Baby choking on food – continues to cough but is now breathing
- Pulled out catheter – canceled by medics – family will transport to urgency room.

Follow-up

- Construction workers waiting for boss to arrive before pulling into driveway.

Extra Patrol

- Reporter wanted semis restricted to drive one road – advised it is a public route. – Reporting party will be contacting State Patrol

- Lawn care services warned for parking in no parking area
- No violations seen – Charlton
- Multiple vehicle warned about parking violation

Suspicious Activity
