SUBJECT: Calls for Service January 20, 2021 – February 19, 2021

Below is a summary of the calls for service during the month of January 20, 2021 through February 19, 2021.

Traffic Stop

- MH – Vehicle stopped in middle of road - driver received a call regarding patient, did not want to talk and drive so pulled over. Very tired. Unsure where to pull over. No impairment observed.
- MH - Citation – No proof of insurance

Suspicious Activity

- **Chief** received phone call from resident regarding a vehicle and male walking the field – red parka, white hat. Arrived and observed vehicle unoccupied by gate on the road. Followed footprints that appeared to be following deer tracks in snow. Officers identified parties upon return to their vehicle. They said there were given permission last year from landowner to be there and take pictures.
- 2 suspicious unoccupied vehicle at end of property. 2 white trucks. Caller noticed about an hour ago – were not there this a.m. Observed 2 vehicles south of the residence. I saw a sled and footprints leading down the hill. Could see a dark figure on ice approx. 5 miles. Believed to be ice fishing. Did not speak with parties but left a card on each vehicle to call officer. Reported to caller.
- Report is newspaper delivery. Multiple mailboxes were open on both sides of road.

Extra Patrol

- Checked popular dumping spot – nothing new observed.
- Vehicle drove to dead end while squad leaving – still hasn't left. Will check later to see if anything left behind.
- Vehicle from earlier is gone and no dumping found.
