1. Engineering Activities Undertaken in the Month of March

The following Engineer's Report reflects the Engineering activities undertaken this past month.

2. Building and Site Reviews in the Month of March

A. Staff conducted reviews for the following properties in March:

- 1 Windy Hill: Staff reviewed the Major Site and Building Plan; CUP request.
- 100 Windy Hill Road: Staff met with the architects and project rep on site to review concept plans. No formal application has been made at this time.
- 1 Sunfish Lane: Staff reviewed the as-built survey for the improvements to ensure they were constructed per the approved plans. Once approved, a final Certificate of Occupancy can be issued.
- 2150 Charlton Road: Staff continues to work with the homeowner on as-built issues.

A. One snow event required clearing/road salting in March.
