SUBJECT: Calls for Service May 20, 2021 – June 19, 2021

Below is a summary of the calls for service during the month of May 20, 2021 through June 19, 2021.

Alarm

Lakeville and Bloomington will check lots for car and check on welfare. Baymont doesn't have record of him checking in last night. Maybe Coon Rapids or Lakeville. Coon Rapids has had no contact. Report has been in contact with father a couple of hours ago. Individual is fine. Cancel missing persons alert.

Premise Check

- Checked area – all good
- Check area
- All quiet

Fire Related

- Single family residential – house filled with smoke – reporter outside and would like to go in to find origin of fire – Directed to stay outside. Fire department located burned food. All additional units cancelled.

Road and Driving Complaint

- Vehicle going 35 mph on 494 and now swerving around – now going just under 62 mph – driver arrested for DWI.

Suspicious Activity

- Saw female try to take mail out of mailbox – female advised she was putting coupons in boxes for upcoming Home Remodel Expo – female left area.
- Small dark colored car parked at end of driveway – parked at end of cul-de-sac – gone on arrival.

Medical

- Sounds like pocket dial, getting voice mail on callback and turned out to be a medical. See next line.
- Patient fell and hit his head. Completely alert. Male is outside at the front door. MHealth cleared police.
- Overdose. Party was transported to hospital.
