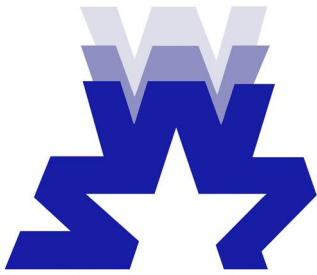
Suspicious Activity
