SUBJECT: Calls for Service November 20 – December 19, 2021

Below is a summary of the calls for service during the month of November 20, 2021 through December 19, 2021.

Extra Trips

- Extra patrol by reserve officers at Salem Rd/Salem Lane area.

Medical

- 82-year-old male fell and has no injuries. He just feels very weak. Police not responding unless requested by medical personnel.
- Caller is reporting 72-year-old wife has been ill. Weak and cannot stand. Officers assisted medics.
- 62-year-old female had a bad fall. She is on blood thinners and currently unconscious. Medics advised they are transporting to regions.
- Child choking. Child is coughing after reporter patted child on back and did a finger sweep. He appears to be breathing normally. Caller is concern whatever it is could be lodged lower. Officer assisted medics.

Fire Alarm

- Smell coming from utility room. CO2 Alarm went off once earlier. No one is reported as sick. MHFD also responded. Homeowner advised of CO2 reading and they are waiting outside for Xcel energy.

Welfare Check

- Male outside of address, seems very out of it saying his girlfriend is missing and said a friend was shot maybe by the mafia. Dispatcher transferring call to Washington County Sheriff's Office to speak with them about missing girlfriend from Lake Elmo. Male does not appear to be a threat to self or others and appears to be suffering from a mental health issue. Per homeowner male is supposed to clean yard preparing for winter.
- Follow-up to above call, reporter was wondering about outcome of previous welfare check. Officer attempted call the party 2 times but received no answer.
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Domestic/Dispute

- Caller state husband is drunk and diabetic. Came home and found him passed out. They are now having an argument. Parties had an argument about drinking and other issues throughout the day. Wife's parents picked up husband for the night.

Traffic Stop
