SUBJECT: Calls for Service December 20, 2021 - January 19, 2022

Below is a summary of the calls for service during the month of December 20, 2021 through January 19, 2022.

Alarm

- Burglar Alarm – Covers front door – Made contact with homeowner who said he accidentally set off the alarm.
- Burglar Alarm- No keyholder response, neighbor had brought mail over.
- Burglar Alarm - Covers front entry doors. Alarm company spoke to a male on site and received proper code.
- Burglar Alarm – All doors and windows secure. As police were clearing, homeowner showed up and advised him of the false alarm. No issues.
- Burglar Alarm – Covers mudroom. Per alarm company cancel as proper code received.
- Burglar Alarm – Lower level family room. Exterior secure. No fresh tracks around home other than the ones from the officers. No keyholders responded.
- Burglar Alarm – Made contact with painter on site without proper code. He was told by homeowner alarm would be off but homeowner must have forgotten.
