I also want to bring up to Council that we have had a couple inquiries about individuals bow hunting on property within the City of Sunfish Lake. There is one known individual that contacted our department who, within the parameters of Ordinance 601, is bow hunting on a property within the City. This individual is a friend of a homeowner that owns a parcel greater than 10 acres and is meeting the setbacks requirements for discharge of a bow from public property, property boundaries, driveways and roadways.. The homeowner has complied with obtaining permission from surrounding properties and has notified the City Clerk.

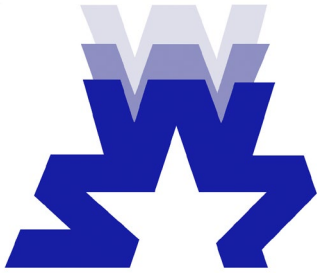
