Below is a summary of the calls for service during the month January 20, 2022 through February 19, 2023.

- Occupied vehicle with female sleeping. No signs of impairment. Employee just needed to sleep as she was just returned from a trip.
- Suspicious vehicle driving through neighborhood the last couple of days. Caller and other neighbors have seen this loud vehicle. Reporter told to call back if they see the vehicle. Telephone call only.

911 Hangup

- Caller seems confused. Officer found he did not need 911 and thought he was talking to a help center when he called 911 by mistake.
- Upon call back female confirmed a misdial.
- Open cell line. Northbound Delaware at highway 62. Voicemail on callback. No priors with cell phone number.
- Nothing heard. Two previous hang ups with this phone number. Voicemail on call back.

Medical

- Wife concerned that husband would continue drinking tonight and have a reaction due to diabetes. Medics checked the male and found no issues with his blood sugar. Male declined to go to hospital.
- Male having a seizure. Wife trying to turn him on his side. Foaming at the mouth. Officers assisted until cleared by medics.
- Male collapsed in the shower and it is hard to tell if he is breathing. The male was found awake and breathing. Officers assisted until they were cleared by medics.
- Medical alarm. Alarm company did not make contact with the patient. No medical issues just trouble with alarm.

These two work as a team to address mental health issues within our communities and I will provide some background on the program and where these two can be assistance to Sunfish Lake residents.
