SUBJECT: Calls for Service -October 20, 2023 – November 19, 2023 and Public Safety Report

Below is a summary of the calls for service from October 20, 2023 through November 19, 2023.

Welfare Check

- Reporter is at victim's home as they had not come into work. They have been ringing bell etc. Mail is on steps. The reporter is not going to stay. Police can call the reporter. Medics called. Victim is being cared for by them. Officers were released from scene.
- Reporter advises sone in law made mention of low sugar and now won't answer. Vehicle is still there. No answer with call, text and knocking. Concerns about alcohol. Entry made by taking pins out of door on porch. Male found Ok and refused medical assistance.
- Party jumping in traffic. Mental health issue. Traffic shut down on Delaware at Mendota Rd and Mendota Rd and Highway 62. State Patrol helicopter assisted. Officers unable to locate the individual.
