The following Engineer's Report reflects the Engineering activities undertaken this past month.

1. Engineering Activities Undertaken in the Month of March

A. None.

2. Public Works Activities Undertaken in the Month of March

- A. Staff have surveyed the outlet structure for Sunfish Lake off of Charlton Road per DNR concern. Staff are continuing to look into solutions to address the DNR's concern.
- B. Staff have ordered "Neighborhood Watch" signs for all public entrances to the City of Sunfish Lake.
- C. Staff have ordered various signs for replacement throughout the City of Sunfish Lake. The signs being replaced show low reflectivity, visible cracking, and loss of color. The signs also include the replacement of absent signage.
- D. Staff are continuing to work with Jim and Jeanine Naves to change their address from 32 55th St W to 42 55th St W.
- E. Staff are in discussions with MnDOT regarding the process of officially changing the street name of 55th St W.
- F. The City of Sunfish Lake follows MnDOT's timelines set for placing spring load limit restrictions. Road restrictions went into effect on Sunfish Lake city streets on March 3, 2025. City staff posted the necessary street signage. It is anticipated that road restrictions will come off sometime in April or May (dictated by MnDOT).
- G. Staff coordinated the replacement of an absent fire number sign at 35 Windy Hill Road.

3. Building and Site Reviews in the Month of March

- A. Staff conducted a review for the following property this past month:
 - 2 Acorn Drive – Staff is reviewing the latest submittal for this property for Major Site Plan.

4. Anticipated Engineering/Public Works Activities for the Month of April

- A. Staff will work with the City's snow plowing contractor to ensure that roads remain safe for travel.
